

DATE OF MEETING: July 3, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MOTION** by Trustee Burweger to appoint Trustee Dan Peters Deputy Mayor. **SECONDED** by Trustee Slocum. There was no discussion; all were in favor and the motion carried.

Ms. Sibyll Gilbert from the Oblong Land Conservancy gave a presentation on the possible purchase of the Hovey property. Ms. Gilbert also voiced concerns about dumping at the Dutcher Avenue pump station.

Mr. Glenn Carey, a resident of Coulter Avenue, said he was concerned with people parking on their front lawns because it devalues the surrounding properties. He also said he would like to see the Village Board do something to address the Pawlingtaxcut.org table that is set up in the mini park on Charles Colman Boulevard during the Farmer's market. He said that people come in on Saturdays to build the community up and when they go to McKinney & Doyle they are told how expensive Pawling is which is negative. Mr. Drew Montgomery, a resident of Quaker Hill Road, said he found the organization to be a positive for the community. There was discussion on the topic.

Mayor Liffland said it was time to update the Master Plan, He said he would contact Dutchess County Planning to see if they could offer assistance. It was decided to make the second meeting of the month a workshop to work on the update.

Trustee Peters said he was waiting on one more quote for repaving Charles Colman Boulevard from Broad Street to West Main Street.

Mayor Liffland said he wanted to have a representative from Welsh come to a meeting to discuss the rates and different scenarios for garbage pickup. The Mayor said he would ask him to attend the July 17<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**MOTION** by Trustee Peters to approve the application from The Grand for a new sign. **SECONDED** by Trustee Burweger. There was no discussion; all were in favor and the motion carried.

**MOTION** by Trustee Peters to approve payment of the May bills in the amount of \$71,922.12. **SECONDED** by Trustee Slocum. There was no discussion; all were in favor and the motion carried.

**MOTION** by Trustee Peters to approve payment of the June bills in the amount of \$55,121.61. **SECONDED** by Trustee Burweger. There was no discussion; all were in favor and the motion carried.

**MOTION** by Trustee Slocum to approve the Metro North Treasurer's Report for May 2017.  
**SECONDED** by Trustee Peters. There was no discussion; all were in favor and the motion carried.

**MOTION** by Trustee Peters to adjourn the meeting and go into Public Comment at 8:04 P.M.
