Please take note that the Village of Pawling, Pawling Joint Sewer Commission (PJSC), Dutchess County, New York will be accepting separate sealed bids, on forms prepared by the Engineer for the Cedar Valley Water Meter Replacements project. The Pawling Joint Sewer Commission will receive bids until 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, November 1, 2018. The work includes, but is not limited to:

Bids will be available at the Village of Pawling, Village Hall, PJSC Office located at 9 Memorial Avenue, Pawling, New York 12564 on Monday, October 15, 2018 after 10:00 a.m. The Information for Bidders, Drawings, Specifications, and other Contract Documents may be reviewed or purchased, for a fee of Twenty Dollars and no cents (\$20.00), at the Village Clerk's Office during normal business hours. Submitted bids shall be in a sealed envelope and clearly marked "**Cedar Valley Water Meter Replacements**" with the bid opening date on the envelope.

Bids will be received by the Village Clerk's Office no later than **10:30 a.m. on Thursday, November 1, 2018** at which time they will be opened and read publicly.

Bidders are also required to comply with provision of Section 291-299 of the Executive Law of the State of New York.
