### Vaccine Update

Dutchess County received notice of a 1,200 dose allocation for this week. Other locations within Dutchess County received the following allocations:

- **3 Hospitals** – 400 Doses Total
- **1 Pharmacy** – 100 Doses
- **FQHCs (6 locations)** – 1,000 Doses Total
- **1 Dialysis Center** – 100 Doses

Dutchess County's weekly doses (including doses allocated last week and delivered this week) will be administered at the following Dutchess County PODs:

- Tuesday 2/23 JCPenney – 800 first doses planned 12PM-8PM
- Thursday 2/25 JCPenney – 400 first doses planned 10AM-8PM
- Saturday 2/27 Dover – 500 first doses planned 10AM-5PM

### Nursing Home & Assisted Living Update

Partnering with NYS to distribute COVID-19 vaccine to nursing homes to vaccinate new residents and staff who may have previously declined the vaccine from the Federal Long Term Care Facility Program (which has come to an end). We are collecting data from nursing homes starting last week to get a count of the need.

## Business Updates

**Summer Camps (day and overnight) will be able to open this summer** NYS promising guidance in the coming weeks

Governor Cuomo has signed an Executive Order **extending closing times** for bars, restaurants, gyms and fitness centers, casinos, billiards halls, as well as other State Liquor Authority-licensed establishments, from 10 p.m. to 11 p.m. statewide, effective immediately.

New York state has announced that beginning March 26, **indoor family entertainment** centers can reopen at 25% capacity.

**Outdoor amusement parks** are allowed to open on April 9, but must be limited to 33% capacity.
