I would like to bring a couple of items to your attention:

Water Supply

Monday, October 4th, I was extremely excited to make an announcement regarding our water supply. After 3 years of working with NYS Department of Environmental Conservation we were finally able to secure our permitting for 2 new sand and gravel wells. This has been my main focus for the last 3 years as this Village was in dire need of additional water supply. We now have 2 wells that each have the capacity to pump 100 gallons per minute. So not only does this provide the water we have needed, but it is also high quality water! With this additional water, we were finally able to begin flushing our water system which had not been done in 15 years. The flushing will continue through the month of October. We have the schedule of the flushing on our website and will update it as necessary.
